14 fat quarters of different blues & greens

Northern Lights, page 6-7

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fat quarters of 15 medium and 15 dark blues for the stars plus 1 additional for piecing

Delete: Obese eighths of 12 additional blues for the blocks

Obese eighths of 17 creams for the blocks & scrappy inner border

Step 1: Begin by stacking 30 medium & dark ... "About Stacking". Divide the stack into 2 piles of 15, or 3 piles of 10 for cutting.

Step 6E: Make (120) stars, (60) navy stars with medium blue backgrounds, and (60) medium blue stars with navy backgrounds.

Step 7: Make 5 sashing rows.
